Project Description: The main objective of the project is to replicate and introduce economic rights and empowerment interventions through sustainable agriculture to community through Knowledge Centres (KCs). These interventions will support women especially the ones in women headed households to generate income and improve their livelihoods.

The project also aims at increasing women's collective and individual voice, bargaining power, meeting household basic needs, increasing entrepreneurial skills in organic production, increased knowledge in marketing and value chain, and increasing decision making at family and community level thus reducing GBV and poverty. The project is also expected to enhance capacity and understanding of Gender equality, equity, women rights and social justice its concepts and women's rights amongst the community through Knowledge Centre members.
